- *Human-environment interactions, social processes, health and wellbeing*
 A special focus lies in research on restorative environments. I explore and analyze psychological and environmental conditions that impact human health and wellbeing (e.g., the role of experiencing psychological distance and fascination for stress prevention and health promotion).
- *Impacts from climate change on quality of life*
 Climate change and global warming likely impact our physical and social environment, and thus our daily life. I am especially interested in impacts of climate change on place identity, place attachment, recreational behavior, and communities (e.g. through neobiota or extreme weather events), as well as in climate change coping and adaptation strategies.
- *Interventions, monitoring and evaluation*
 Designing and applying interventions in the domains of health promotion, stress coping, self-efficacy training, and pro-environmental behavior. Social scientific monitoring and evaluation of changes in urban and rural environments (e.g., evaluation of river renaturation, wilderness parks, etc.).
